Why use ponies for therapeutic work?

Horses are wonderful creatures that can provide friendship, comfort, confidence, physical therapy through riding and other learning experiences. Ponies can also provide an equally powerful yet, perhaps more subtle experience for both children and adults. Their size is often less intimidating than full size horses and can allow a less challenging entry point into the equine assisted therapeutic world. They can be easily groomed, led, bathed and just loved on from a wheel chair. And, of course, ponies can go places a horse cannot go such as inside a hospital, senior home, veterans center, a school or to a feed store or mall for a day of fundraising. They are easier to transport and cost less to feed and maintain than horses.

We are a 100% Volunteer Organization!

No one is paid a penny for the work they do or the time they spend in our organization. We do pay professional fees for accounting, bookkeeping and web site management, but that's it. No salary is paid to any volunteer, director or officer. Every dollar donated goes to supporting our breeding operations and to prepare our ponies for their work in the therapeutic environment.

Pet Partners Registration Discounts

Personal Ponies has negotiated discounts, with the national premier evaluation and registration nonprofit, for <u>folks who lease ponies from us.</u>

Pet Partners evaluates and registers 9 species of animals for therapeutic work. The registration is for 2 years and includes a substantial amount of liability coverage.

It is not a requirement that you register the ponies you lease from us with Pet Partners. We simply want to provide an opportunity for you to gain additional credibility for your organization and have the option of additional liability coverage.

We are confident our ponies can pass the Pet Partners requirements for registration after going through the training with their human team handler!
